

PRE-PROFESSIONAL STUDIES AT CMU

Preparing for a Career in **OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY**

A degree from Canadian Mennonite University (CMU) could prepare you to meet the entrance requirements for studies in Medical Rehabilitation. This page explains what you must complete if you wish to gain admission at the University of Manitoba to earn the Master of Occupational Therapy. If you intend to continue studies at some other university, similar possibilities exist. It is important, however, that you inquire about admission and program requirements at the university you are considering and that you work with the Coordinator of Student Advising at CMU to construct a program of studies at CMU that will achieve your objectives.

Students must achieve a grade point average of 3.0 or more to become eligible for admission. However, admission is on a competitive basis, and normally students must earn a higher average to compete successfully.

To become eligible for admission to Master of Occupational Therapy program at the University of Manitoba, you must earn a baccalaureate degree (i.e., at CMU this could be a B.A., B.Mus., B.M.T. or a B.B.A.). The degree must include the following, with a minimum grade of 'B' in each, and a minimum GPA of 3.0 ('B') in the last 60 credit hours of study:

- PSYC-1010 & 1020 Introduction to Psychology I and II
- MATH-1000 Basic Statistical Analysis
- BIOL-1360 Anatomy of the Human Body
- BIOL-1370 Physiology of the Human Body
- An additional 3 credit hours of social science (chosen from SOCI-1110, ANTH-1610, and GEOG-1010)
- Electives—6 credit hours

Example of a qualifying year for admission to the Faculty of Social Work. Other possibilities exist, so consult with the Coordinator of Student Advising.
